The Summit (February 23-March 2)

My prayer for Life Action as they lead The Summit, February 23 through March 2, is the same as their prayer for us. As Life Action spells it out in their guidelines, "Prayerfully, we will seek God together. Truth and hope will be proclaimed. Lives will be transformed. The church will experience spiritual renewal! Families will be strengthened. The church's fire for the Great Commission will be stroked."

What is Life Action? Why are there so many people? What will they all be doing? In short, Life Action is revival/renewal ministry that travels to churches to equip and minister to the local congregation. They will seek to minister in most all areas of service through the week to be a blessing to us.

Life Action will lead our worship services (Sunday –Thursday) with music ensembles, soloist, corporate worship, and preaching and teaching while running the audio/visual presentation with their order of worship.

Life Action will lead our children's, youth, and adult Sunday School as an investment in and prelude to what will be taught during worship.

Throughout the week, in the Children's department, Life Action will teach the Power of Jesus to our 4 year olds through 1st grade through "Happy Heart City". Children will be welcomed to a city where teachers and various characters will reinforce a life of kingdom action through the power of Jesus. In addition to interactive drama, the children will enjoy creative lessions, crafts, songs, and activities.

Our 2nd through 6th grades will join into "Base Camp" Sunday through Thursday. Upon entrance, children will embark on a unique experience as "climbers in training" to pursue the ultimate adventure of living in action with Jesus. Foundational character principles and Scripture will be presented through music, drama, interactive lessons, and activities.

The 7th through 12th grade student ministry will join in with "Life Action Students". We're calling a generation of youth to get up, get out, and get real. These specialized sessions that complement the main content will help our students think about how Jesus' teachings apply to their daily lives. Our passion is to see teenagers wake up and start a movement that will change the course of this world for God's glory.

Life Action will present a "Women's Luncheon" on Thursday that provides an opportunity for ladies to hear what God has to say about their roles as women made in His image. Through the power of a life's message from our women speakers, your ladies will have the opportunity to connect with God, themselves, and each other.

"Home Life Café" will take place on Saturday, March 2, after the first week of the event from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. The team will facilitate this Saturday seminar with content designed for all ages. They will present content for adults, teens, and children 4 years and older. Children 4 years of age and older will bepart of "Expedition Creation" where they will explore the universe and the creator. Youth will plug into "Flip Sessions" where through clear, Christ-centered, biblical teaching, teen swill be challenged to live for God's gloroy in everyday, practical ways. They will have opportunities to ask questions and hear real-life struggles and victories in small group settings with our youth leaders. This conference is designed to build relationships, present truth, and worship our great God in a relaxed atmosphere. The Adults will set in a relaxed atmosphere, called "Home Life Café", designed for all adults—singles, newlyweds, parents, grandparents, single parents—these discussions will provide you with practical tools for experiencing God's grace in every relationship in your life.

In addition, Life Action will lead us to work through prayer. A Prayer Room will be made available and its use will be encouraged as part of what God is doing throughout the week. Your engagement in this may prove to be the most important part of the week.

As you can see above, Life Action Team Members will be leading in praise and worship with instruments and singing, leading in teaching and preaching, leading in Sunday School and small groups throughout the week ministering to children, youth, and adults, while also leading a special women's event on Thursday and a family conference on Saturday. That takes a whole lot of people to do all of that. We utilize a ton of people to make VBS work. This is much akin to that in many regards.

And they want to do it to minister to you! They don't want you to be busy with preparing a Sunday School lesson to teach, running a children's program, preparing to lead in singing, or many of the responsibilities you might take on to "make the church run" on any given week. For this eight-day period, Life Action wants you to be fed spiritually with only God to focus upon.

Trust that this is God's divine appointment for us as a church. Trust that God had this scheduled long before we knew anything about it. Prayer and trust is where we must be living.




