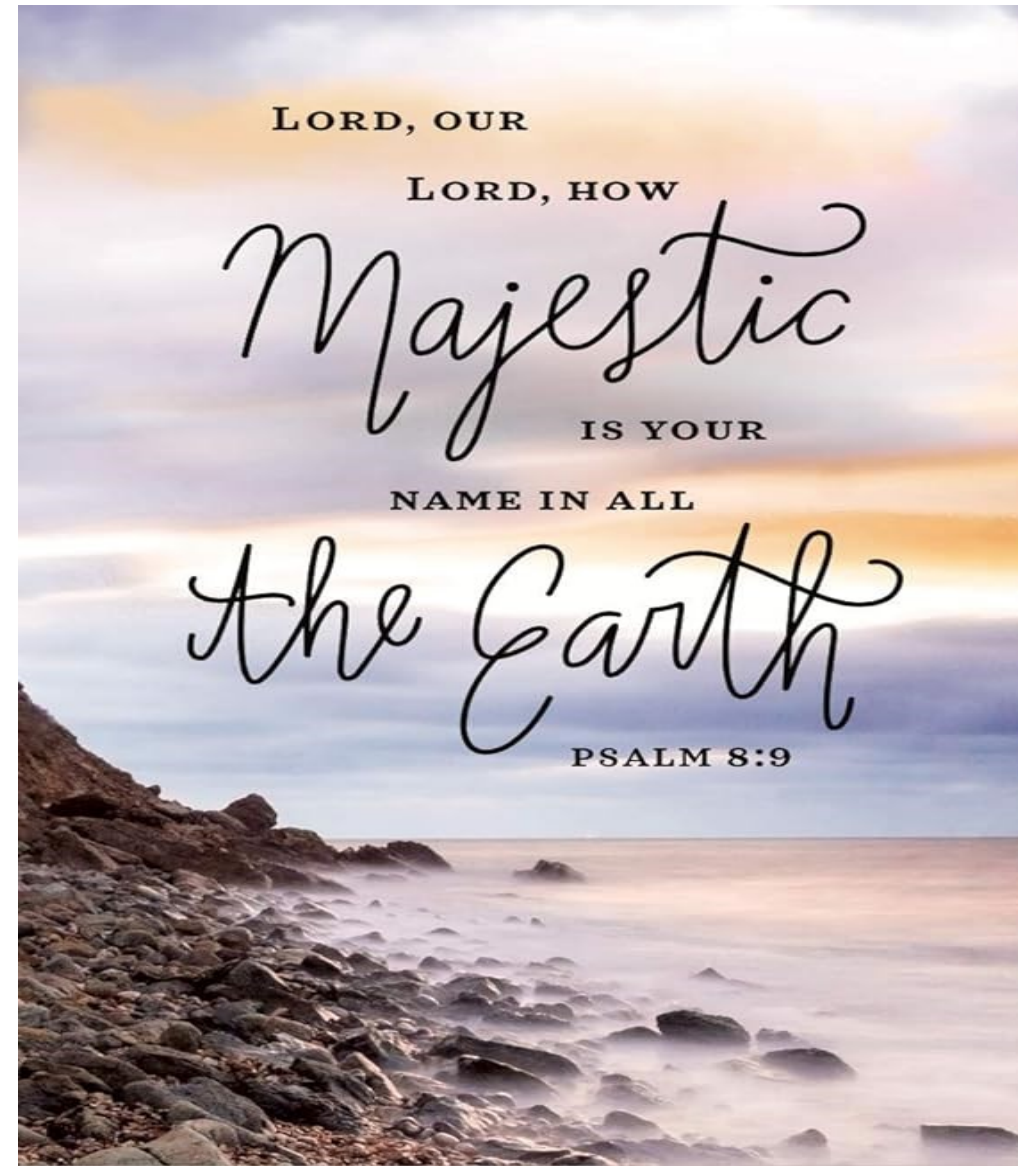

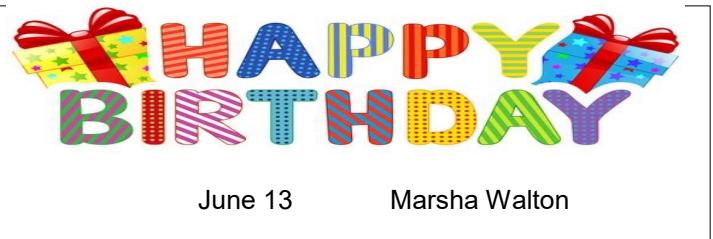

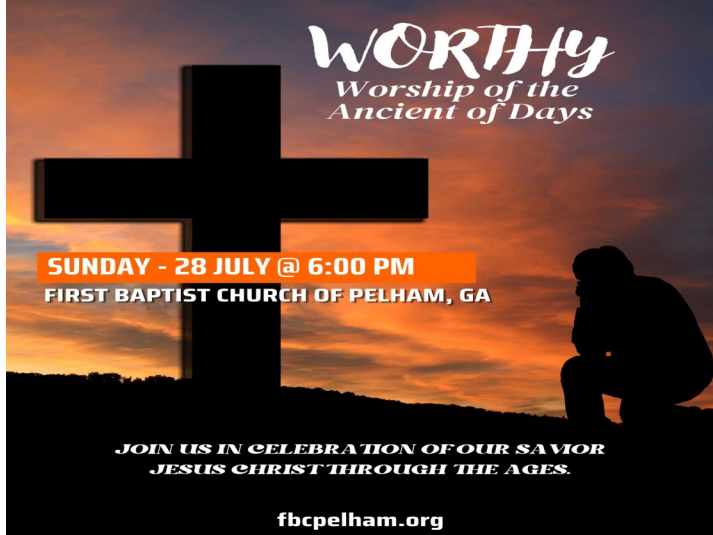


**SENIOR ADULT SUNDAY
